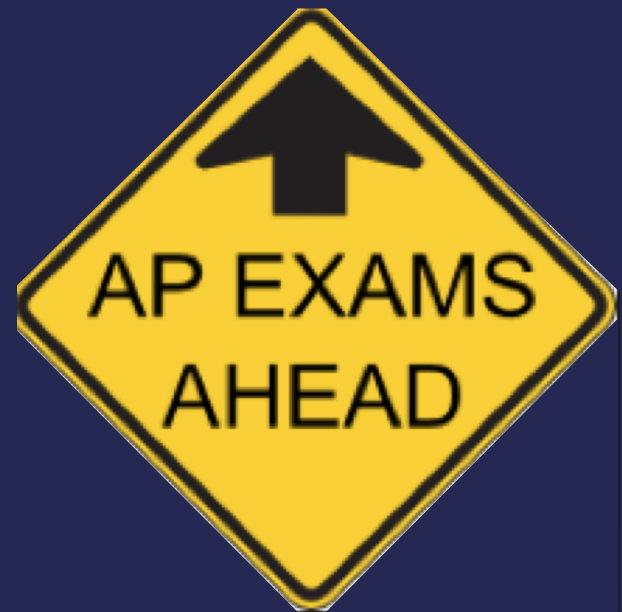

Why take the AP exam?

- All AP students should sign up and take the AP Exam
- Taking an AP exam is a fantastic way to experience taking a college final.
- Save money and time!
- Register early for college courses and get the classes/times you want.



Overview of AP Exam Scores

- AP scores are a weighted combination of the student's score from the multiple choice and free-response sections
- AP scores signify how qualified students are to receive college credit or placement. The final score is reported on a 5-point scale:
 - 5 = extremely well qualified
 - 4 = well qualified
 - 3 = qualified
 - 2 = possibly qualified
 - 1 = no recommendation

- *You must register and pay by midnight on March 29th or a test will not be ordered for you. Late registrations will not be accepted.

Assessments

- AP Testing

AP classes are rigorous academic courses designed for students who are college bound. There is no placement test for AP. Students self-select these courses and should be prepared to work at a college-level pace. At the end of the course, the student is expected to take the AP exam which is managed by College Board.

AP exams are highly recognized by colleges and universities with regard to a student's preparation for the demands of college courses. AP exams present an opportunity for college credit and/or higher placement in college courses. Each college decides which AP exam grades it will accept for credit or placement.

- Any exam(s) not paid for by 11:59 p.m. March 29 will be canceled and the exam(s) will not be ordered.*

Students taking AP exams at Woodinville High School must register for exams here by 11:59 pm, March 29, 2019. For the 2019 AP Exams, the cost is \$104 per exam.

Students must answer all of the questions on the following pages in order to complete the exam registration. A confirmation page indicates that the exam registration process has been successfully completed.

Woodinville High School is excited to offer families the ability to pay their exam fees online at the time of registration. Please be sure to have a credit card or debit card available before beginning registration.

Registrations that are not paid by 11:59 PM, Monday, Apr 1, 2019 will be cancelled and exams will not be ordered.

Frequently Asked Questions

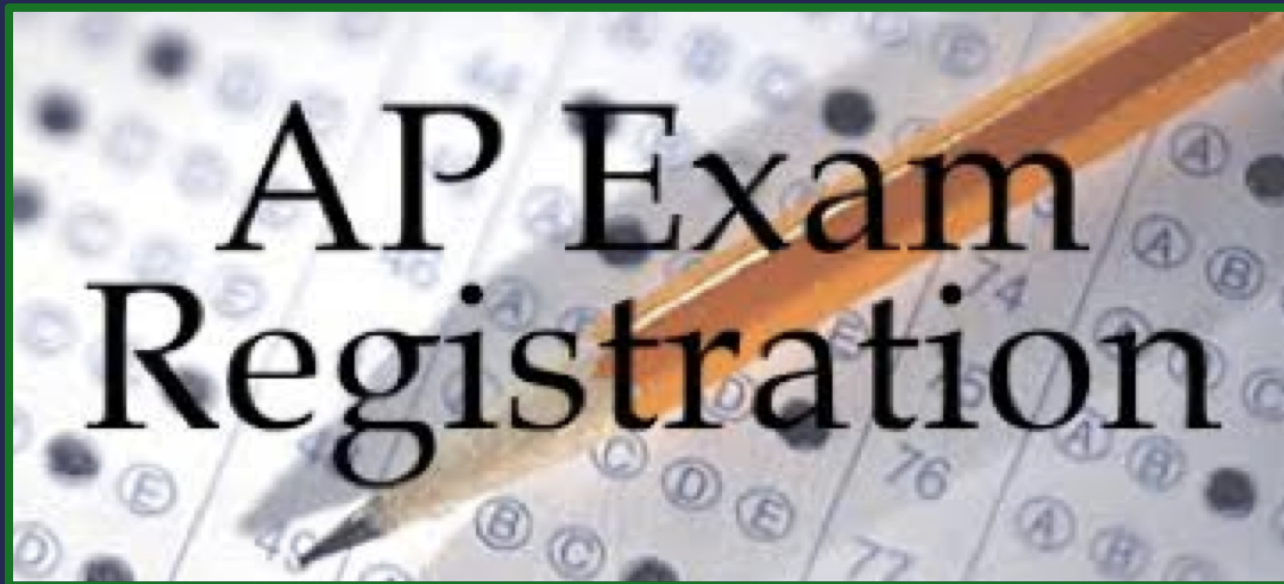
◎ What is the WHS AP exam window absence policy?
